

Adaptive Bike Clinic in Eugene

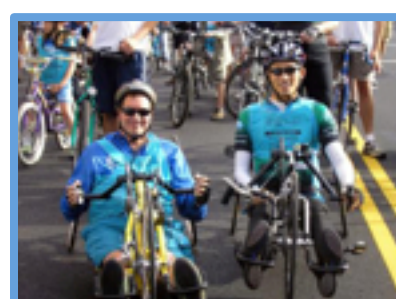
